
As addendum to Memo 001. Term 2.3, AY2021-2022 dated July 6, 2022, the following additional guidelines are hereby promulgated:

1. The CPALE Simulation Examinations are designed to objectively assess the preparation of the graduates and candidates for graduation in the PCU-DILRFI BSA Bridging Program. It also serves as a primary basis in issuing the Transcript of Records of graduating students to be submitted in the application for the CPALE.
2. However, the said SimEx may be participated by all students currently enrolled in the PCU-DILRFI BSA Bridging Program as an advanced training for the CPA Licensure Examinations.
3. Requirements:
 - 3.1. Desktop / Laptop / Tablet / Mobile Phone. Desktop / Laptop devices are recommended.
 - 3.2. Browser (Recommended: Google Chrome, Brave, Mozilla Firefox, Safari)
 - 3.3. Stable Internet Connection (at least 5 Mbps)
4. Steps:
 - 4.1. Go to the CERTS Professional Assessment System (CPAS)
<https://cpas.certs-eduonline.com/>
 - 4.2. Login to CPAS using the same login credentials that you use to access the CERTS-PCU app.
 - 4.3. Click the Simulation Exam Course scheduled to be taken.
 - 4.4. Answer the questions by clicking your preferred choice, then click the "Next" button.
 - 4.5. After selecting your answer for the last / final question, click the "Finish" button.
 - 4.6. Your final score and ranking will be displayed.
5. Schedule and Time Limit
 - 5.1. The Simulation Examination may be taken anytime during the scheduled duration, as follows:
